
## PLEASE READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS AND WARNINGS BEFORE MAKING USE OF THE TURBO-LITE.

## HOW TO USE TURBO-LITE:

- •To ignite the Turbo-Lite: AT THE SAME TIME, press tip of thumb against Cover Lock "A" while pushing down on Ignition Button "B" You must do both actions at the same time or Turbo-Lite will not ignite.
- To refill, turn the unit upside down and firmly push the butane can into the filling valve. The tank should be filled in seconds. Please allow a few minutes after filling
- for the gas to stabilize.
- If no flame appears, adjust the regulator on the filling valve by hand turning the filling valve to the colockwise or countercolockwise directions for an proper
- •To use continuously, switch the Flame Lock (10) to the Lock position after igniting.(6)
- After use, push the Flame Nozzle Cover to lock and make sure that the "hands free" flame lock is in the off position.

## WARNINGS:

- Read instructions before use.
- Do not ignite or use near an open flame, heater, furnace, or combustible material. Do not touch the flame cover during use, or before sufficient time has passed for cooling. Always be sure the unit is cool before storing.
- Store properly when not in use, switch the safety lock to the locked position.
- Keep in a dry place, out of the reach of children.
- Do not attempt to readjust or repair the Turbo-Lite. Unit is not user serviceable.
- Do not use continuously for more than five (5) minutes.





Caution: The torch flame is almost invisible in daylight, or in strong light.
